



Preparing For the Infection Control Exam (ICE)

Requirements for CT Dental Assistants

In the fall of 2016, the CT legislature passed a law that requires dental assistants or expanded function dental assistants to successfully complete the Dental Assisting National Board (DANB)'s infection control examination by July 1, 2018. Upon successful completion of the exam, each dental assistant or expanded function dental assistant shall complete no less than one hour of training or education in "Infection Control in a Dental Setting" every two years. No licensed dentist may delegate dental procedures to a dental assistant or expanded function dental assistant unless the dental assistant provides a record demonstrating successful completion of the DANB infection control examination. In addition, any licensed dentist who delegates dental procedures to a dental assistant shall retain and make records available for inspection upon request of the Department of Public Health.
