Dear Ms. Gerrity and Members of the CSDA House of Delegates,

I am honored to submit my letter of intent to serve as a Delegate to the American Dental Association on behalf of the Connecticut State Dental Association. Having had the privilege of serving as an Alternate Delegate at the 2024 ADA meeting and as a Delegate at the 2025 ADA meeting, I have gained meaningful insight into the importance of strong, thoughtful representation at the national level. These experiences have reinforced my commitment to organized dentistry and my desire to continue advocating for Connecticut's dental community through this leadership role.

During my service at the last two ADA HOD's, I observed firsthand how informed debate, collaboration, and strategic decision-making directly influence the direction of our profession. Representing Connecticut dentists on the ADA floor requires a clear understanding of the challenges facing dentistry today, coupled with the integrity and foresight necessary to address them effectively. I believe my experience, along with my longstanding engagement in organized dentistry, has prepared me well to meet these responsibilities. Each of the last two ADA HOD's has come with its own unique challenges and I believe I have a proven track record of overcoming them and helping others to do the same. Just this last year at the 2025 ADA HOD, I created an easy to follow, detailed, Excel Spreadsheet that the entire First District Caucus utilized to keep track of the exceptionally high number of resolutions there was to go through. This helped maintain the First District's efficiency and effectiveness in a rather unprecedented ADA HOD.

If elected again, my work as a Delegate would be guided by two core priorities. First, I am committed to advocating for our members by ensuring that the perspectives of Connecticut dentists are clearly represented in ADA policy discussions, particularly in areas such as student debt, workforce development, and regulatory policy. Second, I will continue to support initiatives that expand access to oral healthcare, address disparities, and improve patient outcomes across diverse populations.

I currently serve as Vice President of the Connecticut State Dental Association and am a new dentist in private practice. Previously, I held leadership roles as Vice President of the Shoreline

Dental Society and Programming Chair of the New London Dental Society. Prior to assuming my current CSDA role, I was actively involved through service on the Council on Governmental Affairs, Council on Membership, Strategic Planning Committee, and Audit Committee. I also continue to represent CSDA as its delegate to the ADA District 1 New Dentist Committee.

My advocacy efforts span the local, state, and national levels. I have participated in multiple ADA National Lobby Days, beginning as a dental student. Three years ago, I assumed the role of Alternate Team Leader for Connecticut's Second District, coordinating advocacy meetings with Representative Courtney's office on issues affecting our profession. This past year, I served as Alternate Team Leader Coordinator and Chair for the CSDA delegation to the ADA Annual Dentist and Student Lobby Day. These roles have provided me with a comprehensive understanding of legislative and policy issues impacting dentistry nationwide.

In addition to my full-time private practice, I work with special needs patients and teach Dental GPR residents at Samuels Sinclair Dental Center in Providence, Rhode Island, where I completed my residency. This role allows me to serve and connect with a vulnerable patient population while mentoring the next generation of dental professionals.

My combined experience as a practitioner, educator, and advocate has prepared me well to effectively represent the Connecticut State Dental Association at the national level. I am committed to bringing the perspectives of a new dentist, private practice and hospital-based practitioner to the ADA, while maintaining strong communication between the ADA and CSDA. My goal is not only to represent Connecticut's interests nationally, but also to return with insights and resources that meaningfully benefit our members and our profession.
